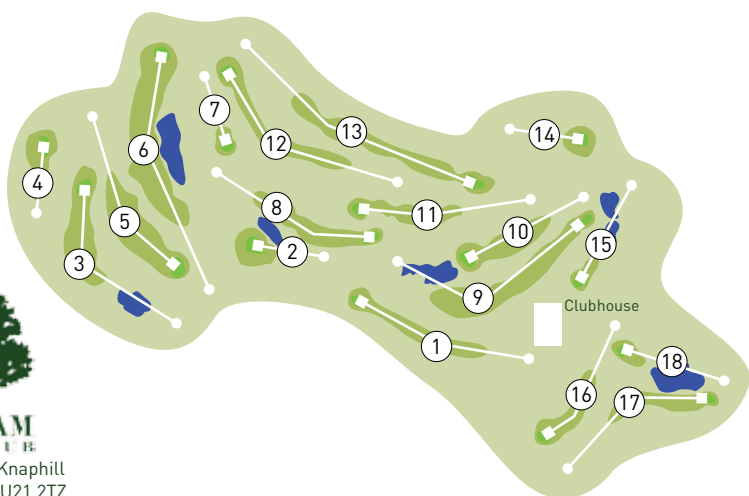

## CHOBHAM GOLF CLUB – LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- A ball lying on or over any boundary fence or on or over a bridle way or road is out of bounds.
- When playing the 3rd hole a ball lying to the right of the white posts is out of bounds.
- When playing the 9th hole a ball lying to the left of the white posts is out of bounds.
- A ball lying on the practice ground is out of bounds.
- Any ball lying in the Car Park or Clubhouse area is out of bounds.

### 2. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions [Rule 24/1 applies].

### 3. WATER HAZARDS

All lakes, ponds, streams, and drainage ditches on the course are water hazards. [Rule 26 applies].

Water hazards are marked by yellow stakes.

Lateral water hazards are marked by red stakes.

Where it is impractical to determine whether the ball is in the hazard or to do so would unduly delay play, a ball shall be played provisionally under any of the available options under Rule 26/1. In such a case, if a provisional ball is played and the original ball is found in the water hazard, the player may play the original ball as it lies or continue with the provisional ball in play, but may not proceed under Rule 26/1 with regard to the original ball.

### 4. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

Rules of Golf - specimen local rule which is Appendix 1 part b - 6

### 5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS [Rule 24 – 2 applies].

All Greenkeepers buildings, sheds and half way houses and bridges, man-made pathways and railway sleeper steps, the white stakes to the right of the 5th and left of the 10th fairway are immovable obstructions.

### 6. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

Protection of young trees identified by stakes or artificial supports. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24 – 2b (i) [Immovable Obstruction], the ball may be cleaned when lifted.

### 7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- All areas that have been circled with a white line are areas of ground under repair. All drainage lines old and new are also to be considered ground under repair. Relief must be taken under Rule 25-1.

### 8. PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN

A ball coming to rest on the practice putting green must not be played as it lies. The player must take relief from a wrong putting green under Rule 25-3. For the purpose of Rule 25-3 the practice putting green includes the apron surrounding the putting green.

Stroke Play – two strokes Match Play – loss of hole.
